THE COMMUNITY BENEFITS


In line with Community Benefit Fund Guidelines, governed by the Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland (SEAI), and based on the current project scope, Tullacondra Green Energy will generate a Community Benefit Fund estimated at €3.75 million over the first 15 years of operation. This amounts to approximately €250,000 per annum. There will be opportunities for residents to engage directly to manage the allocation of the financial contribution.

Description	% of Fund	Annual Amount
Initiatives and projects that support Sustainable Development Goals within the local area	40%	€100,000
Local clubs, societies and near neighbours	50%	€125,000 shared between those closest to the project and the balance will be allocated to local clubs, societies and near neighbours within 2km of turbine.*
Administration	10% (Max)	€25,000
